UNIFORM POLICY

On the Top:

- ❖ Solid colored light blue, navy blue, royal blue, or white collared shirts free from logos or stripes is to be worn daily. Shirts may be short or long sleeved.
- ❖ Solid colored light blue, navy blue, royal blue, or white sweaters, sweatshirts, or fleece jackets, without a hood, may be worn over collared shirts during the school day. Corporation policy does not allow for hooded clothing to be worn during the school day.
- ❖ Solid colored light blue, navy blue, royal blue, or white short or long sleeved t-shirts worn under collared shirt.
- ❖ Shirts are to be tucked into pants, shorts, skirts, or skorts.

On the Bottom:

- ❖ Navy blue, black, or khaki pants, skirts, skorts, jumpers, shorts, or capris are to be worn daily.
- ❖ Socks/tights/leggings must be navy blue, black, khaki, or white. Leggings are allowed only when worn under a jumper or skirt. Blue jeans, and sweatpants are not permitted.
- ❖ Skirts, skorts, jumpers, and shorts are to be at or below knee level. Shorts are not permitted between November 1st until the week after Spring Break.
- ❖ A belt is to be worn if pants, skirts, skorts, or shorts have belt loops.
- ❖ Shorts, skorts, capris, or pants must properly sit at the waist, no sagging.

On the Feet:

- ❖ Shoes are to be tennis shoes, dress shoes, or close-toed sandals with a strap around the back of the foot. Tennis shoes must be worn to participate in Gym.
- ❖ Flip-flops and open-backed sandals or shoes are not permitted as they present a safety hazard on the playground equipment.

On the Head:

- ❖ Hair is to be a natural color. Bright artificial dyes or sprays are not allowed.
- ❖ Headbands, barrettes, and hair clips should not have attachments that rise more than 1" from the scalp (i.e., no unicorn horns, large bows/flowers, etc.).

Dress Down Days/Spirit Days:

Designated Dress Down Days/Spirit Days are opportunities for students to express their personalities and spirits by wearing clothing that does not meet the above Uniform Policy guidelines.

Please remember that the SBCSC does have a Dress Code that applies to all schools every day:

- ❖ Pajama pants or tops are not permitted unless participating in a designated Spirit Day.
- ❖ Hats, caps, and bandanas are not permitted unless participating in a designated Spirit Day.
- ❖ Sleeveless tops, including tank tops and spaghetti strap/athletic strap tops, are not permitted.
